AWCM Functions

- Responsible for validating University-wide adherence to a coherent framework of quality learning programs for Acquisition, Technology and Logistics (AT&L) positions (i.e., e-Learning, resident and on-site courses).
- Conducts evaluation of the curriculum delivery effectiveness (faculty and course quality assessments).
- Provides DAU staff oversight in regard to the establishment, maintenance, and enforcement of quality and performance standards to govern curriculum content and delivery of courses through the DAU learning programs, the curricula review process, and the DAU academic course evaluation program.
- In support of the President, serves as the University liaison to the DoD Chancellor for Education and Professional Development, regarding accreditation, resourcing and professional development standards; Functional Advisors (FA) and respective Executive Secretaries regarding content requirements; Directors for Acquisition Career Management (DACMs) regarding fiscal year instructional throughput requirements and associated academic policy; responsible for Acquisition Workforce (AWF) education training and career development policy; and the Executive Leadership initiatives with the Advanced Distributed Learning (ADL) Co-Labs regarding strategic policy, planning, and standards for the ADL.
- Serves as principal educational liaison to external organizations; oversees the management and sustainment of the DAU course equivalency program for both internal DoD and external institutions; manages and sustains the DAU ACE accreditation program; and oversees the continuing education unit (CEU) program.
